

Split Entrances & Morning Independent Reading

For better traffic management within the school, we ask:

- Foundation and Years 5 and 6 students to enter and exit the building via the entrance to the Basketball Court; and,
- Years 1-4 students to enter from the Adventure Playground.

Only Foundation parents are allowed in the school building for drop offs and pick-ups, but QR Code is required.

All parents are welcomed to continue accessing the Reception, but note that QR Code is required.

Once the bell goes at 8:50am, all students will now be expected to enter the building and participate in independent reading. This will allow us to manage their hand hygiene more easily and have students use the reading time more effectively to ease into the learning by 9am.

Start of Year Admin Paperwork

Thanks to the adoption of Compass, we have been able to simplify the start-of-year administration process significantly.

This is because two of the annual notices and forms are now automated as part of the 2022 Voluntary Contributions collection process.

We thank families that have made their 2022 Voluntary Contributions (the new name for Parent Payment Policy) and we encourage families that have not yet completed the process to do so as early as possible. This will help to ensure that you have:

- Signed the **2022 ICT Acceptable Use Agreement** (in order for your child to access any digital ICT equipment in schools)
- Acknowledged the APS Photographing Filming and Recording Students Policy and provided consent (or notice to opt out)

If you would like to make your contributions over the counter via EFTPOs or Cash (instead of CompassPay), you will be required to complete the paperwork above via hard copy available from the Reception.

If you would like to make your contributions at a later date, please drop by the Reception to pick up hard copies of the two forms mentioned above for completion. This will ensure your child is permitted to start using digital ICT equipment at school.

Junior Rockers

Junior Rockers will continue to be our provider of individual or small group instrumental music lessons during school hours. Sign-ups are available directly via Junior Rockers. From 2022, Junior Rockers will also provide keyboard and piano lessons.



Medication and Medical Action Plans


Assemblies & Newsletters
